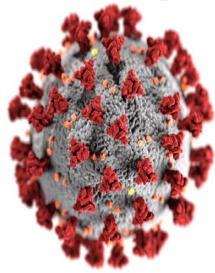


TEXAN FLOOR SERVICE DISINFECTION SYSTEM

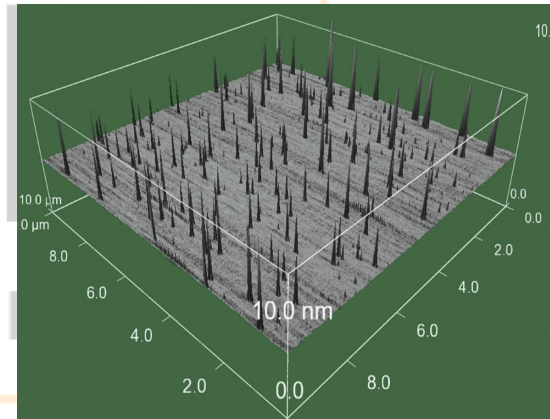
The Texan Floor Service Disinfection System (the “Texan System”) is a unique and easily applied liquid concentrate that proactively protects virtually all solid surfaces and fabrics from pathogens including coronaviruses. Specifically, the Texan System is a microbiostatic antimicrobial coating that not only disinfects, but provides **long-term protection** against future contamination of treated surfaces. On application, the Texan System reduces existing pathogen populations by up to 99.99% on contact, and continues to inhibit the return of pathogens anywhere from **90 days to more than a year**. This long-term protection is not achieved by standard disinfectants. Without this extra level of protection, pathogens rapidly re-populate. Most importantly:



Active chemistry incorporated as part of the Texan System has been approved by the EPA for use against SARS-CoV-2, the coronavirus that causes the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The Texan System meets the EPA’s emerging pathogen requirements for viruses showing efficacy against envelope and non-envelope virus, both large and small.

The active chemistry in the Texan System polymerizes to all surfaces and is both colorless and odorless. The Texan System leaves no discernible trace. Threatened surfaces have the same look and feel as untreated materials. Unlike protective coatings that kill by “poisoning” other pathogens, The Texan System’s mechanical or kinetic kill prevents the pathogen’s ability to mutate or breed new variants that are then resistant to treatment.

Think of the active chemistry in the Texan System as a layer of electrically charged spikes. When a pathogen comes in contact with the treated surface, the quaternary amine spike punctures the cell membrane and the remnants are then electrocuted. Since nothing is transferred to the now dead cell, the antimicrobial does not lose its strength and the spike is now ready for the next cell to contact it.
